CLT AIRPORT - REGIONAL ECONOMIC IMPACT


\$16.2 Billion annual direct and indirect economic impact


PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES

- Steering Committee of all funding governments and private sector
 - Donny Hicks represented Gaston County EDC
- Funding of \$230,000 equally divided between public and private sectors
- GGDC managed project, contract, and fiscal accounts
- Hired MXD Development Strategists (had prepared CLT AASDP)
 - Team included Lyerly Agency and Kimley-Horne
- Plan encompassed ALL of Gaston County


TIME-DISTANCE ECONOMIC SECTOR TARGETS




ECONOMIC MOBILITY CORRIDORS




ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AREAS




ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AREA: LINEBERGER TRACT
