

RESOLUTION
ENDORISING APPLICATION BY GASTON COUNTY
FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT FOR A
STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT AT CENTRAL PARK IN CRAMERTON

WHEREAS, the Town of Cramerton has recently improved Central Park by uncovering a previously buried, piped stream that runs through the park and into the South Fork River; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cramerton has adopted a Stormwater Master Plan to improve stormwater runoff and stream health within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cramerton, as a member of the South Fork River Health Committee, seeks to find ways to improve the health of the South Fork River and its tributaries: and

WHEREAS, Gaston County Natural Resources has announced their intent to apply for a stream restoration grant to restore the stream banks of this unnamed tributary to the South Fork River;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Cramerton Board of Commissioners endorses Gaston County Natural Resources applying for the Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Water Infrastructure's ARPA Stormwater Grant for a stream restoration project along the unnamed tributary of the South Fork River within the property limits of Central Park.
