- 3. The service side arm, Glock, Model 22, Serial Number SGH991 be permanently retired by the Gaston County Sheriff's Office and offered to Retired Major Robert Porter at a price of \$1.00.
- 4. The Gaston County Sheriff's Office is directed to award Major Robert Porter with the service side arm and badge as specified and worn by him during his service to Gaston County, in accordance with the North Carolina General Statutes and policy of the Board.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners expresses their sincere gratitude for the dedicated service of Major Robert Porter, and wish him the best in his retirement.
