- WHEREAS, the Gaston County District Attorney's Office launched its first Families of Homicide Support Group in 2024, a significant step in providing dedicated support to those affected by violent crime; and,
- WHEREAS, we believe in honoring the memory of victims and acknowledging the resulting long term trauma for families and communities. This National Day of Remembrance is an essential way of promoting public awareness and remembering our loved ones; and,

- WHEREAS, it is our unwavering commitment to honor those who have lost their lives to violent crime and to stand with families who have experienced such profound loss; and,
- WHEREAS, we urge all citizens of Gaston County to join in our first ever National Night of Remembrance for Murder Victims Candlelight Vigil on September 25th at the Rotary Pavilion beginning at 7:00 pm.
