

- WHEREAS, Assistant Police Chief Stephen V. Jentsch retired from the Gaston County Police Department on November 1, 2023 after serving 27 years with Gaston County; and,
- WHEREAS, Assistant Police Chief Stephen V. Jentsch has requested that he be awarded the service side arm, Glock, Model 45, Serial Number BRTV433 and badge worn during his service with Gaston County Police Department pursuant to G.S. 20-187.2, and Board Resolution #259 dated October 27, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gaston County Board of Commissioners that:

- 1. The badge worn by Assistant Police Chief Jentsch and his service side arm, Glock, Model 45, Serial Number BRTV433 be declared surplus equipment.
- 2. The badge worn by Assistant Police Chief Jentsch be given to him as a remembrance of his service with the Gaston County Police Department.
- 3. The service side arm, Glock, Model 45, Serial Number BRTV433 be permanently retired by the Gaston County Police Department and offered to Assistant Police Chief Jentsch for a purchase price of \$1.00.
- 4. The Chief of the Gaston County Police Department is directed to award Assistant Police Chief Jentsch with the service side arm and badge as specified and worn by him during his service to Gaston County, in accordance with the North Carolina General Statutes and the policy of the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners expresses their sincere gratitude for the dedicated service of Assistant Police Chief Stephen V. Jentsch and wishes him the best in his retirement.
