NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gaston County Board of Commissioners that:

1. The badge worn by Captain James Bailey and his service side arm, Glock, Model 23, Serial Number SGH995 be declared surplus equipment.
2. The badge worn by Captain James Bailey be given to him in honor of his service with the Gaston County Sheriff's Office.
3. The service side arm, Glock, Model 23, Serial Number SGH995 be permanently retired by the Gaston County Sheriff's Office and offered to Retired Captain James Bailey at a price of \$1.00.
4. The Gaston County Sheriff's Office is directed to award Captain James Bailey with the service side arm and badge as specified and worn by him during his service to Gaston County, in accordance with the North Carolina General Statutes and policy of the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners expresses their sincere gratitude for the dedicated service of retired Captain James Bailey, and wish him the best in his retirement.
