URP (Grant Program)

-Gaston County Urgent Repair Grant Program-

- Gaston County was awarded URP Grant funds to rehab houses.
- URP program funds come from the North Carolina Housing Trust Fund and are overseen by the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency.
- Funds enable recipient organizations to provide deferred, forgivable loans of up to \$8,000 for emergency home repairs and modifications to very low-income owner-occupied homes.
- Eligible households are those with one or more full-time household members with special needs (e.g. elderly, disabled, and/or veteran full-time household members or a child 6 years or younger with an elevated blood-lead level). Household incomes cannot exceed 50% of area median income.
- This is a competitive process, and individual counties can apply for up to \$100,000 in project funding cycle per year through the NCHFA.

Gaston County URP Program (Take Away)

- After the completion of 2017 URP funding cycle, Gaston County will have successfully renovated 31 homes after bringing the program in house in 2016.
- Average renovation ranges are \$5,000 to \$8,000 per home.
- This allows the elderly, handicap, single parents, and veterans that meet the established criteria for the program to stay in their homes.
- NCHFA numbers demonstrate that for each year a person can remain in his/her home, there is a cost savings of \$48,000-\$50,000 to the tax payer. This is the cost equated to housing an individual in a retirement home.
- \$200k in Grants.(31 homes x \$50,000yr.) = \$1,550,000 (\$1,550,000 x (5) years) = \$7,750,000 (10) years) = \$15,500,000
- Further savings to a County, City and Town. Slowing and/or preventing the dwelling from falling into disrepair, thus maintaining property values and tax base.

Cherryville, NC : replace deteriorated sills, porch and create handicap access to drive.

Belmont, NC: restore water and rebuild well house.

Mount Holly, NC : Convert entire bathroom to handicap accessibility; shower, sink, toilet, and door access.
