The Gaston County Board of Commissioners (BOC) met in Regular Session at 3:00 pm on December 12, 2023 in the Harley B. Gaston, Jr. Public Forum, Gaston County Courthouse.

Chairman Chad Brown presided with Commissioners Bob Hovis, Vice-Chairman; Cathy Cloninger, Allen R. Fraley, Kim Johnson, Tom Keigher and Ronnie Worley in attendance.

2023-417 Commissioner Worley – Finance – To Amend Gaston County ARPA Grant Project Ordinance 2021-264 to Approve and Appropriate Project Funding – Homeless Projects (\$375,000); To Amend Board Action 2022-002 to Extend the Performance Period for Short-Term Emergency Housing Assistance as follows:

Section 1: This ordinance is to establish a budget for a project to be funded by the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds of H.R. 1319 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (CSLRF). Gaston County has received the full \$43,612,126 allocation of CSLRF funds. These funds may be used for the following categories of expenditures, to the extent authorized by state law.

- 1. Support public health expenditures, by funding COVID-19 mitigation efforts, medical expenses, behavioral healthcare, and certain public health and safety staff
- 2. Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency, including economic harms to workers, households, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector
- 3. Replace lost public sector revenue, using this funding to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic
- 4. Provide premium pay for essential workers, offering additional support to those who have borne and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical infrastructure sectors
- Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure, making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water, support vital wastewater and stormwater infrastructure, and to expand access to broadband internet.

**Re: Cold Weather Shelter**: The County Manager advised she provided the BOC a full update on the Cold Weather Shelter at their seats and noted it has been operational eight times this year and is getting more activity than previously; she will keep the BOC updated on the status.

#### **County Attorney's Report**

The County Attorney noted he met with the Interim County Attorney (Ms. Courtney C. Rogers) and the incoming Attorney (Mr. John D. Joye) to review current County matters and believe those matters are poised for a smooth transition.

He thanked the BOC for its trust in allowing him to serve as County Attorney for two years and stated it has been a privilege.

#### Other Matters

**December 10, 2023 Newspaper Editorial (regarding local leadership and homelessness)**: Commissioner Keigher stated he spoke with the County Manager about an editorial in Sunday's paper (*My Turn: What's going on with leadership vacuums?*) written by Dwayne Burks, and noted he was taken aback by the negativity directed toward the County and local cities in the area; none of the good things were mentioned; spoke with the County Manager and she provided some information about the County's efforts; the problems actually lie within the cities (particularly those that border I-85); wanted to see if the County is expeditiously still working on the procedures/goals and achieving what it set out to do.

Chairman Brown stated he saw the article and expressed his frustration noting the County's past work and ongoing efforts. He noted in 2018 and 2019, the County began its work to create a community-wide strategic vision (One Gaston 2040) to help shape the community and allow it to continue to grow and thrive; these efforts led to the establishment of a countywide homeless task force. The task force report recommended creating a *Homeless Prevention Committee* made up of countywide representatives; the community met monthly for two years coordinating with communities to create a cold-weather shelter. The County also committed \$1M of ARPA funds to reduce the harm felt by the homeless community and provided shower and laundry facilities.

The County has been a leader in coordinating the community-focused response to help those most in need within our community and continues to do so as we go forward to accomplish our goals throughout the County. There is still work to be done. He asked the County Manager to comment. The County Manager advised the Homelessness Task Force has been meeting monthly for the past two years to try to forward this work; structurally, inside the County, a community services group led by Dr. Greg Grier was created to lead this effort; it is not just a County responsibility and that is part of the challenge in terms of moving speedily – the County is working with the City (Gastonia), Salvation Army and all partners to move this forward. She concluded that it is a piece of the County's strategic plan and a part of the 2040 vision and would be happy to provide a more detailed report on the steps that the Homelessness Task Force is working through.

Chairman Brown thanked Commissioner Keigher for emailing Mr. Burks about the article.
