The Gaston County Board of Commissioners (BOC) met in Regular Session on July 24, 2018 at 6:00 pm in The Harley B. Gaston, Jr. Public Forum, Gaston County Courthouse.

Vice-Chairman Tom Keigher presided with Commissioners Allen R. Fraley, Don Grant, Bob Hovis, Tracy L. Philbeck and Ronnie Worley in attendance.

Chairman Chad Brown was not in attendance.

Others present included Earl Mathers, County Manager; Samuel Shames, Assistant County Attorney; and Donna S. Buff, Clerk to the Board.

Upon request of Vice-Chairman Keigher, Commissioner Fraley led those assembled in the Invocation and Commissioner Grant led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Public Hearing - Re: Commissioner Worley - Planning - To Approve Naming of Private Drive as</u> Simonds Farm Rd

Vice-Chairman Keigher announced the Public Hearing as advertised; explained procedures to be used; called for the motion to enter into Public Hearing.

On motion introduced by Commissioner Worley and seconded by Commissioner Hovis, the BOC unanimously entered into Public Hearing.

Vice-Chairman Keigher introduced Mrs. Sarah Penley, Planning GIS Specialist III, for comments.

Mrs. Penley advised staff was presented with the property owner's petition bearing 100% signatures requesting to name a private drive, which accesses parcels 227925 and 227926 located off of Cramerton Road (South Point Township); Applicant owns two parcels with a combined acreage of 29.30 acres; one parcel has road frontage along Cramerton Road with an existing home; the other parcel has permits for new construction; Applicant wishes to name the drive accessing the property as Simons Farm Rd which is a non-duplicating road name and acceptable for 9-1-1 use. She reviewed the property's location via vicinity and aerial maps depicting the property's location in the vicinity of the corporate limits of Cramerton, City of Gastonia, as well as the ETJ for the Town of Cramerton, Town of Lowell and the Town of McAdenville; noted the smaller parcel close to the road is the site of the new construction; notices were mailed per County policy; no calls have been received to date; staff recommends approval of the application as it fulfills the requirement set forth in the *Addressing and Road Naming Ordinance*.

Vice-Chairman Keigher called for citizen comment and for questions from the BOC; hearing none, called for a motion to approve.

On motion introduced by Commissioner Grant and seconded by Commissioner Fraley, the BOC unanimously approved Resolution **2018-180** as follows:

WHEREAS, the Gaston County Planning Board is authorized to provide recommendations for Street Naming or Street Renaming of roadways in the unincorporated areas of Gaston County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners approve the road name changes as follows:

Naming of private drive as Simonds Farm Rd

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager is authorized to make the necessary notifications to the appropriate State and local officials.

Vice-Chairman Keigher called for a motion to close the Public Hearing.

On motion introduced by Commissioner Hovis and seconded by Commissioner Grant, the BOC unanimously closed the Public Hearing.

# 2018-190 Commissioner Keigher - County Attorney - To Approve an Interlocal Agreement for Construction of Water Infrastructure to Connect Bessemer City with the Two Rivers Utility System (\$158,333)

Commissioner Hovis introduced a motion to approve and Commissioner Philbeck provided the second.

Vice-Chairman Keigher called for discussion.

Vice-Chairman Keigher advised that the County and both municipalities will benefit from the economic development impact of the project; however, the City of Gastonia and Bessemer City will make a profit from the water that is sold. He recalled his initial support of the project was based on the County also participating in the shared profits. He expressed his concern that the County is fronting money and will not share in the return.

Commissioner Philbeck agreed but advised that the BOC directed staff that for future projects, if it is a profit making venture, the County would be reimbursed; this should be the last project to come before the BOC where the County will not recoup some of its dollars.

The County Manager advised the County will recover significant amounts of revenue as the economy further develops; it is important to have this for the South Ridge Business Park and for the protection of Bessemer City's domestic water source; it also supports the BOC's desire and mission to have countywide water; the City of Gastonia has built in a recovery mechanism above a certain threshold of sales; if Bessemer City achieve sales of .75 million gallons/day that revenue generating mechanism kicks in and the County will be reimbursed; there is no assurance that will

happen, but if their standard sources of water begin to decline, the County will begin to recover some revenue.

Commissioner Philbeck reiterated that the formula was achieved at the BOCs direction; would like to see a more equitable formula in the future.

Vice-Chairman Keigher concurred and advised that he would support the agreement.

Commissioner Hovis recalled the earlier discussion to create a cost recovery mechanism for utility services; it would be similar to a short-term, no interest loan and needs to be further defined as we move forward. This interconnection, once completed, will allow Bessemer City to purchase all of their treated water from Two Rivers Utilities; prior to this proposal, the only option was their contract with the City of Kings Mountain; that contract was used as leverage to allow Bessemer City to achieve an equitable rate with Gastonia; Bessemer City's water plant is 32 ½ years old on a 30-year design and will need major upfit in the short term; it does not make sense for Bessemer City to upfit a facility that does not provide enough water. The Long Creek facility's flow is greatly diminished due to an engineering oversight which should have been caught when the interconnection was originally created; however; the new infrastructure, which will consist of a pressurized pump station, will correct that problem.

Commissioner Fraley stated he would support the project for the sake of economic development and to move in the right direction for countywide water.

Vice-Chairman Keigher called for the vote, and the BOC unanimously adopted Resolution **2018-190** approving an Interlocal Agreement for construction of water infrastructure to connect Bessemer City with the Two Rivers Utility System per Budget Change Request:

**Re:** Sale of County Properties: Commissioner Philbeck asked if the BOC would agree to direct the County Manager to look at options for selling County property, with the goal being to attain the best monetary return for its citizens, including 1) looking at the cost and process of listing properties on www.Govdeals.com; and 2) the cost benefit of using a local realtor to market and sell County property. He requested that staff provide a report at the next meeting.

Vice-Chairman Keigher concurred and recalled that several years ago some properties in Reflection Point (Belmont), valued at \$75k to \$190k, were brought to the BOC with an offer of \$14k and \$24k; would like to see staff develop alternatives for getting a better return on property.

Commissioner Grant noted that he spoke with the Govdeals representative at the NACo Conference; noticed the County has some, but not all of the surplus properties on Govdeals; Bessemer City relisted a residential property on Govdeals when they did not get the minimum bid and got \$42,000; listing properties on Govdeals opens it up to any bidder worldwide, and the only cost to the County is paying an employee to list it on the website; County needs to look into this to get the most value for the taxpayer.

Commissioner Worley advised that he and Commissioners Grant, Hovis and Fraley were involved in some of the conversations about the value of that option at the NACo conference.

Commissioner Hovis asked if the County listed a minimum dollar amount on surplus properties.

The Assistant County Attorney advised the County does that for tax foreclosures to cover outstanding property taxes.

Commissioner Hovis suggested the County should try to achieve a minimum amount above the taxes; would like to get older properties returned to the tax base; would like the County to look at setting a minimum, for example of 30% of the property tax value plus the back taxes owed as the starting point for auctioning foreclosed properties; he asked staff to look into this and report on how to update the County's current process.

Commissioner Worley proposed a County policy of at least 50% of the tax value.

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#### GASTON COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

Vice-Chairman Keigher asked staff to provide a report at the September Work Session.

Re: North Carolina Association of County Commissioners (NCACC): Vice-Chairman Keigher cited his concern regarding the amount of raises given to NCACC staff which included a \$5,000 raise for the Executive Director, which brings him to about \$213,000 in his fourth year; NC counties pay a large annual membership fee which contributes to the NCACC's \$3M/year annual budget and its fund balance of \$17M. He added that NCACC staff and its Executive Board recently felt it was prudent to give a \$500k donation to the UNC School of Government to use as they deem necessary. He suggested that counties may be paying too much for their memberships if the Association can afford to make such large donations; he encouraged Commissioners planning to attend the NCACC Annual Conference to discuss that topic with other commissioners.

#### **Adjournment**

Vice-Chairman Keigher called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.

On motion introduced by Commissioner Worley and seconded by Commissioner Fraley, the BOC unanimously adjourned the Regular Meeting of July 24, 2018 at 6:39 pm.
