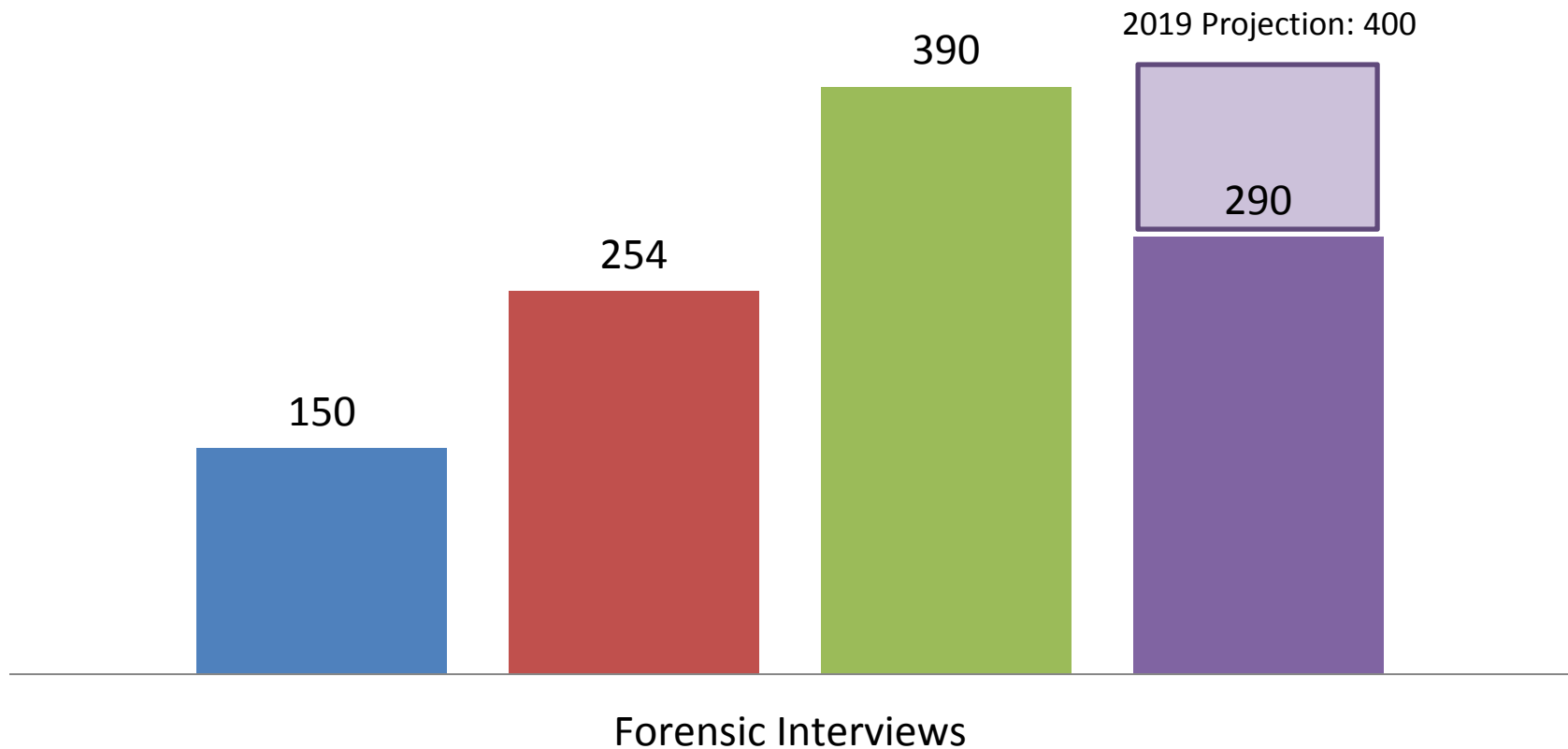

Fire clears way for kids' advocacy center

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Flames and a plume of dark smoke soared from a former house at 3100 Bethlehem Church Road during a controlled burn in Gastonia on Friday morning. Firefighters from multiple area departments burned the home, which was donated from Bethlehem Church, to clear the way for the new Gaston County Children's Advocacy Center building. "The property gets burned to clear the way for the new building," said Heather Kaufman, supervisor at the Children's Advocacy Center. "So it's really a win-win for our community all around."

Also known as The Lighthouse, Gaston's Children's Advocacy Center is a child-friendly and neutral location for children to share their stories while the child and family receive various services. The Lighthouse also provides community education for child sexual abuse prevention.

The organization has

seen a sharp increase in the number of interviews with children over the past year, warranting the need for a larger facility, said Kaufman.

The Lighthouse has been operating in the Highland Health Center since April 2016. The house on Bethlehem Road was previously used by Bethlehem Church and for group meetings from other organizations. The new facility will feature a dedicated therapy wing for individual and group therapy, and the ability to offer play therapy. It also will have a more homelike atmosphere with living room and kitchen settings and other general living spaces.

The building plan is still a work in progress, though Kaufman showed a preliminary design Friday. These plans call for a one-floor layout in a 7,700-square-foot space. Kaufman said the project "has been a dream for a long time" and expressed her gratitude for the community's support, particularly Bethlehem Church.
