Medical Plan Historical Overview



- Gaston County Medical Plan History:
 - The last funding increase was 2015 2016. Including no change for 2019 – 2020, that makes 4 years of no additional tax-payer dollars allocated to the Medical Plan.
 - The County Commissioners approved a very successful dependent eligibility audit and spousal eligibility change occurred for 2015 – 2016.
 - The last plan design change occurred during the 2016 2017 Plan Year.
 - Normal increases in Medical Plan costs average 8% increases per year.

Medical Plan Historical Overview



- While most Medical Plans would average a 32% increase in costs in the past four years, Gaston County's total Plan trend since 2014 2015 has been negative 9.8%. Pharmacy trend since 2014 2015 has been negative 8%.
- The difference in normal trend and Gaston County's trend is \$7,000,000 of cost avoidance.
- Why:
 - Wellness Initiatives the County has employed.
 - Spousal Eligibility Criteria Change.
 - BCBSNC Network Discounts

Medical Plan Historical Overview



- Gaston County Medical Plan History:
 - The Stop-loss (catastrophic) coverage is reviewed every year.
 - In 2010 2011, the Stop-loss coverage was moved from BCBSNC to VOYA, saving the County \$140,000.
 - Since 2010 2011, the marketing/review/negotiation efforts avoided over \$1,300,000 of additional fixed cost.
 - The County has received fair value from the Stop-loss contracts.



- Reasons for a Pharmacy Benefit Manager RFP:
 - While the County Pharmacy spend is **8% below the 2014 2015** levels, it still **makes up 23%** of the total medical spend.
 - As the dynamics of the pharmacy benefit business evolve, ensuring that the County has competitive contracts in place is good business practice.
- Reasons to hire a Pharmacy Benefit Consultant:
 - Understanding and evaluating the nuances of pharmacy benefit contracts is a specialized skill set, that requires a high level of technical expertise and knowledge.



- Timeline:
 - September 2019:
 - September 10, 2019
 - Advise the County Commissioners that a Pharmacy Benefit Management review should be conducted and request authorization to conduct a consultant evaluation process.
 - Begin Interview of Consultants.
 - Determine needed services.
 - Obtain cost for services desired.



Timeline:

- October 2019:
 - Craft recommendation to the County Commissioners.
 - If appropriate, obtain authorization on October 22, 2019 to move forward with the selected Consultant from the County Commissioners.
 - Consultant to meet with County to start RFP process.
 - Consultant begins the RFP development process.
 - Obtain needed data from Prime Pharmaceuticals for the RFP.
