









92,400 new residents between 1970 and 2023.

83% moved into municipal areas.




















Where Residents Work

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Between 1990 and 2023, Gaston County's private sector employment declined by 6%. Median county change was +24%.







Service sector jobs make up a greater share of jobs than in 1990; true in most of NC and US.






Per capita income is below the statewide average.

These data are adjusted for inflation.



From 2018-2023, Gaston County's GDP increased by 9%. The median county change was +6%.


You're looking at how each month's sales tax collections compared to the same month of the prior year – Feb. 2021 versus Feb. 2020, for example.








Like most of the state, your collections have trended up from the pre-covid era.

But, since FY 2022-23, the trend is almost flat. This isn't uncommon compared to other counties.





Even if every county <u>collected</u> an identical amount of sales tax, no two counties would receive the same <u>distribution</u>.






Sales Taxes

 The State's complicated formulas redistribute the first 2¢ of tax among the counties.

Example: Oct. 2024 Collections

- Gaston County: \$7.24M in collections
- Onslow County: \$7.26M in collections
- Difference: \$28,000
