

RESOLUTION TITLE: TO AUTHORIZE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
GASTON COUNTY AND BELMONT, BESSEMER CITY, AND
MCADENVILLE TO DESIGNATE A JOINT HISTORIC
PRESERVATION COMMISSION AUTHORIZING GASTON
COUNTY TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THOSE MUNICIPALITIES
AS THE CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT

- WHEREAS, it is important to safeguard the heritage of the County and municipalities by preserving any historic landmarks therein that embody important elements of its culture, history, architectural history, or prehistory; and,
- WHEREAS, the County established a Historic Preservation Commission in 1990 (Resolution 90-124); and,
- WHEREAS, Section 160A-461 of the North Carolina General Statutes authorizes any unit of local government in North Carolina and any one or more other units of local government in North Carolina to enter into contracts or agreements with each other in order to execute any undertaking; and,
- WHEREAS, the municipalities of Belmont, Bessemer City, and McAdenville wish to designate a joint historic preservation commission authorizing Gaston County to act on behalf of those municipalities as the Certified Local Government.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gaston County Board of Commissioners that it hereby authorizes the execution of Interlocal Agreements between Gaston County, Belmont, Bessemer City, and McAdenville designating the Gaston County Historic Preservation Commission as a joint historic preservation commission to exercise those powers and duties given to it by and under Chapter 160D of the North Carolina General Statutes, Gaston County Historic Preservation Commission Ordinance, and the Gaston County Historic Preservation by-laws.
