#### **CRS Quick Facts**


- ➤ The Community Rating System is a FEMA program administered by ISO (Verisk Analytics)
- Recognizing communities that go beyond minimum NFIP standards
- ➤ Implemented in 1990
- Incentive based voluntary program
- ➤ 19 creditable community Activities
- > Communities can pick and choose these Activities
- Based on a 10 Class system. 500 pts. per Class
- > 5% insurance premium discount per Class








#### 1,391 Participating Communities

#### **CRS Savings**

- Gaston County
  - 56 policies
  - \$54,960 in premiums, \$86-146 average policy
  - Savings of \$5,496, \$46 \$73 per policy average
  - > \$40 per policy savings over a Class 9 (\$4,823 County-wide)
