

Gaston County joined the State in the National Opioid Settlement. This BCR appropriates Year 1 \$125,533.42/Project Total\$376,600.26 of our allotment for Evidence-Based Addiction Treatment through expansion Medication Assisted Treatment for uninsured and underinsured Gaston County residents at Kintegra Health. Funds will enable Kintegra Health to hire staff members and cover the cost of medications and required labs. In addition to medication for the treatment of opioid use disorder, Kintegra Health will ensure individuals needing mental health or substance use treatment can have same-day, convenient, and affordable access (either virtually or face to face) to behavioral health consultation and intervention services.
