NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gaston County Board of Commissioners that:

- 2. The badge worn by Sergeant Robert Monaco be given to him in honor of his service with the Gaston County Sheriff's Office.
- 3. The service side arm, Glock, Model 22, Serial Number SXV764 be permanently retired by the Gaston County Sheriff's Office and offered to Retired Sergeant Robert Monaco at a price of \$1.00.
- 4. The Gaston County Sheriff's Office is directed to award Sergeant Robert Monaco with the service side arm and badge as specified and worn by him during his service to Gaston County, in accordance with the North Carolina General Statutes and policy of the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners expresses their sincere gratitude for the dedicated service of Robert Monaco, and wish him the best in his retirement.
