- WHEREAS, our community, across all aspects of faith-based, non-profit, corporate businesses, volunteer and professional organizations continues to support individuals and families; and,
- WHEREAS, dedicated child welfare professionals and community partners work to achieve permanency for children through reunification with birth parents; and,
- WHEREAS, June is Family Reunification Month, and an opportunity to recognize families who have successfully overcome the challenges that brought their children into out-of-home care.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners hereby proclaim the month of June 2022 as
