BACKGROUND

The North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Adult Corrections and Juvenile Justice awarded funds in 2022 to fund a pilot Traffic Teen Court in Gaston County JCPC for fiscal year 2022-2023. On June 6, 2023 the JCPC received notification that a decision was made to continue the pilot project through FY 2023-24 and that additional discretionary funds in the amount of \$12,302 were awarded for FY 2023-2024. The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council approved this revision at its June 13, 2023 meeting. No county matching funds are required.

Dear Ms. Farmer:

We recognize and appreciate the efforts that the Gaston Teen Court program made during the 2022 – 2023 fiscal year and the progress in implementing and offering the traffic teen court pilot program in Gaston County. This pilot endeavor has produced some positive outcomes during this current fiscal year. However, this current year also required program development, instructor selection, training for instructors to teach the *Alive at 25* classes, and promotion of the program in the community. A decision was made to continue the pilot project through the 2023 – 2024 fiscal year to allow the Section to better assess the impact of the traffic teen court model and its outcomes based on a full complete year of implementation.

Based upon your request for fiscal year 2023-2024, your agency has been awarded DPS funds in the amount of \$12,302 for the upcoming fiscal year for this project. This amount must be added into the 23-24 Program Agreement in NC ALLIES in order to align your 23-24 teen court budget with these additionally awarded DJJ funds. Please be sure to include the source for inkind match offered by the Safety and Health Council of North Carolina, including access to a free annual membership to the SHC of NC, a \$500 value, access to the Alive at 25 curriculum and training offered by the SHC of NC, supportive use of the Council's database, and free access to the participant Alive at 25 student workbooks, valued at \$10 each. These generous in-kind calculations should be reflected as match within your budgets. As a reminder, please ensure that you have indicated adequate match to support funds awarded.

Outcomes for this target population and pilot project will continue to be stringently tracked and monitored. Please know that we wish to offer continued assistance to you in our efforts to support the work that you are doing. It is our desire to study the success of this pilot project so as to inform possible statewide expansion to other interested teen court programs.
