

CTP - Comprehensive Transportation Plan
MTP - Metropolitan Transportation Plan
TIP - Transportation Improvement Program
MPO - Metropolitan Planning Organization

TIP 10 YEARS

25+ YEARS

CTP

- Non-fiscally constrained
- Required by NCDOT
- Starting point for identifying and documenting transportation needs
- Framework for selecting future transportation projects
- Minor updates as needed; full update ~every 10 years by county, MPO, or NCDOT

MTP

- Required by FHWA
- Fiscally constrained
- Identifies transportation projects prioritized for funding over next 20+ years
- Updated every 4 years by MPO

TIP

- MPO's short-term programming document (includes schedule and funding source)
- Updated and approved by MPO every 2 years
- Incorporated into the state TIP



Why Develop a CTP?

- Identify existing and future transportation needs
- First step in the NCDOT project delivery process
- Projects must be reflected in the CTP before County can submit them for future funding available through NCDOT and GCLMPO
- NCDOT refers to CTP when implementing its Complete Streets Policy







- Gaston, Cleveland, and Lincoln counties are part of the GCLMPO planning area






