

RESOLUTION TITLE: TO AMEND RESOLUTION 98-299: TO ESTABLISH THE JUDGE WILLIAM GASTON AWARD

- WHEREAS, the Gaston County Board of Commissioners established the Judge William Gaston Award on October 22, 1998 to recognize Gaston County citizens who have rendered exemplary volunteer service to the County; and,
- WHEREAS, the award is presented in the fourth quarter of each calendar year to recipients who have been nominated and selected by the Board of Commissioners with service to at least one committee, commission, board or advisory group appointed by the Gaston County Board of Commissioners or receiving direct county funding with said service occurring in the current calendar year; and,
- WHEREAS, in order to preserve the distinction of this award, the Commission has determined that the award should be presented to no more than one recipient per calendar year.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners hereby amends Resolution 98-299: *To Establish the Judge William Gaston Award* by decreasing the number of award recipients from "three" to "no more than one recipient" per calendar year.
