Crowders Mountain Volunteer Fire & Rescue, Inc. (CMVFR) and its Board of Directors are requesting a certificate of need for the construction of Station 03. We have done our 'due diligence' with researching everything you may want to know about this service area and property/station. In 2014, CMVFR received a rating of 7/9E. The total number of properties within the 9E rating in 2014 was 848 properties with a tax value of \$67,980,154. CMVFR looked at its options and decided that the best option for the community was to build a third station. (I would be willing to review our options with the FAB). The FAB approved for the purchase of land which CMVFR currently owns, and by approving this certificate of need for the station our project will be almost completed. Our station will be built in a high populated area where the majority of our residents are on a fixed income. It will provide a lower ISO rating which will lower insurance premiums and put money back into the pockets of our shareholders. CMVFR currently has the apparatus to staff the station. This station will reduce response times for emergencies which will support CMVFR mission of saving lives and property.

The 2017-2018 debt services analysis for CMVFR along with an up-dated budget sheet is also attached for your viewing.
