This project will	i enable a collabor	ative effort	among commur	nity partners	s to implement a	a transitional	I housing program	

along with supportive services to address the urgent need of assisting victims of domestic violence who have left an abusive relationship to achieve financial stability and independence. Currently, there is no transitional housing program available to serve these victims. Supportive services will identify and provide support to victims of DV both in the community and within the battered women's shelter so that recovery can occur. The grant will also cover the costs of clinical therapists to work with this population. Statistics documented by the Gaston County Sheriff's Office, The Shelter of Gaston County, Court Advocates, and Phoenix Counseling, indicate that over 1500 victims of domestic violence seek help and safety through community resources in Gaston County every year.
