

## **RESOLUTION TITLE:**

TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO THE NORTH CAROLINA MINING COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPENLY DISCUSSING PIEDMONT LITHIUM'S PROPOSED MINING ACTIVITIES IN GASTON COUNTY AS DETAILED IN THE COMPANY'S STATE MINING APPLICATION

- WHEREAS, Chapter 8 of the Gaston County Code of Ordinances concerns the health and safety of the citizens of Gaston County; and,
- WHEREAS, Piedmont Lithium, Inc. submitted a mining application to the State of North Carolina on August 30, 2021 proposing an array of open-pit mining operations in the northwestern part of Gaston County; and,
- WHEREAS, citizens throughout Gaston County have voiced and continue to voice significant interest in Piedmont Lithium's proposed mining activities in the County; and,
- WHEREAS, Gaston County wants its citizens to have a thorough opportunity to be heard, respected, and informed as to the potential risks and benefits of a project of this size and scope; and,
- WHEREAS, North Carolina's Mining Act of 1971 provides, in pertinent part, that the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (the "Department") shall hold a public hearing whenever the Department determines that significant public interest exists regarding any new mining application.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gaston County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality schedule and notice a public hearing on Piedmont Lithium, Inc.'s North Carolina Mining Application submitted August 30, 2021.
