BACKGROUND

The Board of Commissioners is responding to a request to dedicate the proceeds of the Article 46 Sales Tax to new school construction and improvement to existing schools and to place a conditional sunset on the time that the Article 46 Sales Tax will be effective if approved. If approved the Board is agreeing that the proceeds of the Article 46 Sales Tax will be used for debt service to build new schools and to improve existing schools and that another advisory referendum will be scheduled in 2048 to determine whether the sales tax should be repealed.
