BACKGROUND

The City of Mount Holly is entering into an interlocal agreement with the City of Charlotte concerning wastewater treatment operations. Under this agreement, certain real and personal property of the City of Mount Holly is to be transferred to the City of Charlotte. Under G.S. 153A-15, Gaston County must consent to this transaction, as the City of Charlotte, located outside of Gaston County, is obtaining property from a city within the County. Gaston County has no ownership interest in this property.
